We cannot realistically cost your dental care until we have examined you carefully and know you better. We can discuss your fees openly. We will put the treatment plan in writing.

## Our Terms and Conditions

It is our policy to ask patients to pay for treatment on the day of each appointment.

Payment can be made in cash, by cheque or credit card.

If you need to cancel a dental appointment, we would prefer a minimum of 24 hours' notice.

However, we do understand emergencies can occur that require less than 24 hours' notice.

Charges for missed appointments maybe levied if less than 24 hours' notice is given.

The charge would usually be up to 50% of appointment missed.

Treatment plans can alter and if they do so we will inform you well in advance of what those changes entail. In that event an amended treatment plan will be provided.
